Welcome to the 2008 Turner Hall Golf League!

1. The league will officially start on April 1, 2008 at Twin Springs Golf Course in Bolton, MA.
2. To kick off the season, we start with a Polar Bear Blind Draw Tournament (April 1st and April 8th). Winners of the Polar Bear will be awarded \$20.00 per person. Team play will begin on April 15th, 2008. Handicaps will be used for the Polar Bear draw.
3. A "MIDWAY", tournament will be held at the half way mark, around June 17, 2008. A cook-out will be held on that same day. This will take place under the pavilion at the club.
4. The Thirteenth Annual Gerry Mayou Golf Tournament (Play Day) will be Held on Saturday, Sept 13th at Kettle Brook Golf Club.

General information:

Dues will be \$110.00 per person. Officers will not pay dues. All dues must be in the Treasurer's hand by May 6th, 2008. If your dues are not paid, you will not be allowed to play unless you have made previous arrangements with the Treasurer.

Greens fees will be \$14.00.

Tee times are reserved from 2:45 pm to 5:45 pm. If a league follows us, alternating tee times will begin at 4:30.

All golf league members MUST be a Paid Up member of the Turner Hall. Former members of the golf league, in good standing, will get first priority on the waiting list. Members of the Turner Hall, in good standing, will get second priority on the waiting list. All others will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Please see a Secretary to get on the waiting list.

A list of rules, regulating league play, has been adopted to insure a more pleasurable experience for everyone.

Rules Committee: Phil Johnson, Jr., Charlie Rouleau, Pat Ball and Kerry Lee have been appointed to make all the decisions related to disputes on the golf course. If you have any questions regarding proper play, please contact this committee for rulings.

Rain Committee: The Board will have the responsibility of calling off scheduled matches due to inclement weather. Decisions will be made by 2:00 pm. Please check your email, call Turner Hall or call Twin Springs, if you are not sure.

1. In the event of rain after the start of golf, any completed matches are official. Any matches not started will be made up in accordance with rule #6. Any matches that are in progress will be made up from the last finished hole in accordance with rule #6.
2. In the event the official lighting horn sounds, please clear the course. Mark your ball and immediately stop play. All matches that are completed are official. Any matches that are not started will be made up in accordance with rule #6. Any matches that are in progress will be delayed until the rain committee either resumes play or cancels play. If play resumes, play will continue from the last completed hole in accordance with rule #6.
3. Any unsportsmanlike like behavior will be reviewed by the rules committee and subjected to forfeiture or suspension from the league.
4. Each hole is worth ONE POINT.
5. For play-offs, if there is a tie at the end of your playoff match, the first playoff hole will be #1 then #2 and so on until a winner has been determined. If any of the playoff holes are stroke holes, strokes are to be used.
6. Handicaps will be recalculated on a weekly basis. The handicaps will be posted with your team and individual standings at Turner Hall and at the Pro Shop at Twin Springs. The difference between your handicap and your opponent will be administered on a hole by hole basis, starting with hole #3, #9, #6, #7 and then in accordance with the score card.
7. All matches **MUST** be completed on the Tuesday scheduled! Pre-arranged make-ups will only be allowed if they are finished on or before the following Tuesday's match. This includes any and all vacations!
8. All no-shows/forfeits will be scored in the following manner: The person that shows up will receive 9 individual points and 7 team points. The no-show will receive 0 individual points and 2 team points. All make-ups for the first half must be completed and submitted to the secretary prior to the last scheduled matches for that round. In the case of an injury, the injured player must consult the Board for a ruling **PRIOR** to the scheduled match or the match will be considered a forfeit.
9. You may roll the ball in your OWN fairway only, six inches and no closer to the hole.
10. We will play point-of-entry, drop, 1-stroke penalty for all balls that are out of play (in the woods, OB, etc.). Hit **ONLY ONE** ball from the tee box. If the ball is hit OB or lost, drop a ball at the point of entry, as far back as you want as long as you maintain the line from the tee box to the entry point. The only exception to this rule is Hole #6, where we will establish a drop area within 5 paces (in any direction) from the water cooler. If you hit the ball into the woods on #6 and can't find it, take a drop near the water cooler, hitting 3 (one in, one out).

11. No ball is to be removed from the ball rack until that group has teed off.
12. Scorecards: Only **ONE MATCH** per scorecard is allowed. After your match is completed, turn your **DATED, SIGNED AND ATTESTED** score card in to John Beary or drop them off at the beer money box. (you know, the box you are supposed to put money in when you take a beer) If an incomplete score card is turned in, it will result in a forfeited match for both players. Do not leave your scorecard at the golf course. If you are playing a make up match, please bring your scorecard to the Turner Hall and give it to the bar tender. Tell the bar tender to give it to John Beary. All scorecards are official once they are turned in, **SO MAKE SURE THEY ARE CORRECT BEFORE YOU SIGN AND SUBMIT THEM.**
13. All substitutes will play on Tuesdays and establish a handicap. If someone drops out of the league a substitute with an established handicap will be eligible to replace him. Substitutes will be eligible to participate on Play Day.
14. Individual and team play will be recorded, and cash prizes will be given out. A cash prize will be awarded to the winners of Play Day.
15. **PLAY DAY:** If you can't play, you have the option of finding someone to take your place. There will be no refunds. If you **DO NOT SHOW**, the league will be coming to you for reimbursement of the amount we pay the course.
16. **PLAYOFFS:** You **MUST** play two separate rounds. You can't play one match and have it count for both weeks. You must also play the match at Twin Springs.
